Anthropology Colloquium Series: Aaron Seaman, PhD



Aaron Seaman is a medical anthropologist in the Colleges of Medicine and Public Health at the University of Iowa and at the Iowa City VHA Healthcare System. He will discuss his work across these spaces, focusing on recent research to understand the experiences of LGBTQ+ individuals in Iowa who are at risk of or are living with a cancer history. In doing so, he will explore the role of an anthropological perspective in the multidisciplinary spaces of team science, the challenges of this research in our current sociopolitical moment, and the opportunities to imagine and shape what comes next.
