



Summer 2026 Department of Anthropology Archaeological Field School

Students will learn up-to-date techniques of archaeological survey, testing, excavation and recording. They will also get experience in analysis and artifact curation, and gain skills that will serve in a wide variety of future of archaeological jobs. All necessary field equipment and recording forms for the field school will be supplied. Students will be evaluated based on participation, learning, and practice of excavation and recording techniques.

The site is Secrest Farm and Octagonal Dairy Barn in Johnson County, near Downey, Iowa, about 20 minutes southwest of Iowa City. Students are responsible for their own lodging and meals during this course. Transportation to and from campus will be provided during the field work.
